

- Approximately 80
 employees and their
 families turned up for the
 event
- 17 children were present
- Print Manager ran 40 miles in 4 hours and 47 minutes
- Many employees biked the 40 miles or a portion of it
- Raised £4,226.65 for the children's burns unit at a local hospital (over \$6000 USD)



Walk a Profession for a Woman

- Charity walk where donations are used for women in developing countries
- Helps women in the poorest regions get training, professions, and independent livelihoods
- 28 of the 54 women employees at Bemis Valkeakoski in Finland participated
- Motivation and work welfare speech (Exervise, Endurance, Hope) given by a local congressman at the closing of the event



According to our survey, "Work-Life Balance" came out as No. 1 topic of interest. Hence, we selected this topic as professional development key event.




